LUUK VAN MIDDELAAR (1973) is a political theorist and historian. He is a professor of EU law at Leiden University and a political commentator for NRC Handelsblad. Van Middelaar was the chief speechwriter to European Council President Herman Van Rompuy (2010-2014). He published his first book, Politicide, in 1999. Since its original publication in 2009, his study The Passage to Europe, translated into more than ten languages, has received the European Book Prize 2012 and other prizes. His most recent books are Alarums & Excursions (2019), Pandemonium (2021) and Le Réveil géopolitique de l'Europe (2022). Since 2018, Luuk is member of the Dutch Advisory Council on International Affairs.
